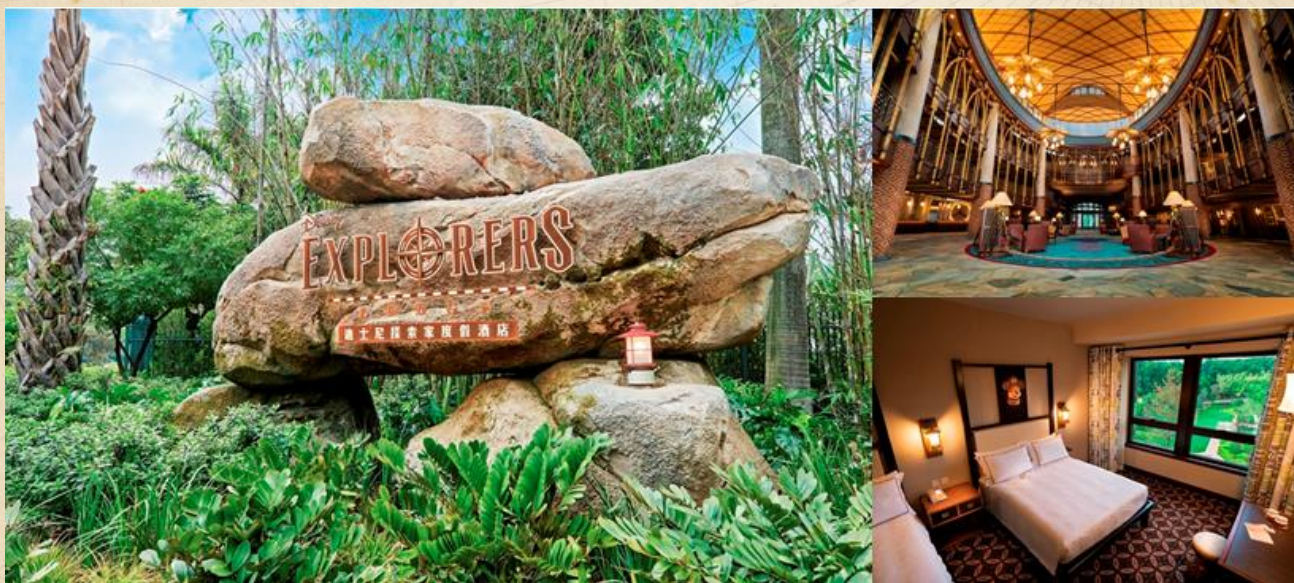

Hong Kong Disneyland Resort Disney Explorers Lodge Factsheet



Hong Kong Disneyland Resort's third hotel—Disney Explorers Lodge—will open its doors on April 30, welcoming guests to a brand-new hotel experience in Hong Kong filled with exotic adventures! Hotel guests will be able to explore landscapes, art and cultures across Asia, South America, Africa and Oceania. During this one-of-a-kind hotel experience, they can also enjoy an incredible selection of exploration-themed memorabilia and go on an immersive dining journey at new themed restaurants!

Disney Explorers Lodge Overview

Disney Explorers Lodge is Hong Kong's first adventure and leisure themed hotel, filled with exotic Disney elements. The seven-story hotel has 750 hotel rooms, each featuring an open sea view or a landscape view.

The design and architecture of Disney Explorers Lodge, along with its four wings and themed gardens, showcase the cultures of Asia, Oceania, South America and Africa. Throughout the hotel, over a thousand pieces of art and artifacts from around the world¹ are displayed. These include ceremonial items, antique toys, crafts, textiles, clothing and jewelry. The displays can be found throughout the lobby, guest rooms, restaurants, kids' corner and the various indoor and outdoor areas.

Room Specialties

Nearly 70% of the rooms can be connected in Disney Explorers Lodge, allowing guests the flexibility of both personal space and the ability to communicate with friends and family in adjacent rooms. “Disney In The Stars” fireworks can be viewed in close to 50 rooms, while some rooms feature bay windows overlooking the sea view or gardens below.

Design Theme

The 750 guest rooms are elegantly designed, incorporating design elements from the lodge’s four different areas: Asia, Oceania, South America, and Africa. The overall feel is one of warmth, earthy patterns, dark timbers and the colors of the world’s forests, complemented by the occasional animal print.

Overall, the rooms are elegant, high-end, extremely comfortable and designed as if the outdoors were brought inside. Wall coverings and lights in the hallways for each wing were also inspired by the hotel’s four unique themes.

Each room features a large mirror and a drum-shaped stool, while there are also four different types of Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse tiki-styled masks on the headboards styled after each wing.




Amenities

Up to four adults can be accommodated in each room with two queen-size beds. To allow for a more open room layout, the bath is separate from the sinks, making them and other bathing facilities more readily accessible. Children’s amenities are also available to accommodate families, including children’s bathrobes, toothbrush sets, bathtubs and stepping stools.



Four Themed Gardens and Wings

The hotel’s four themed gardens, named after characters from Disney and Disney•Pixar movies, along with the four themed wings of the hotel, celebrate the unique landscapes and cultures of Asia, Oceania, South America and Africa.

Layout <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Showcases a collection of lanterns and artifacts collected from Asia and India, such as a carved stone fountain and stone lanterns. – The upper garden features a pond with a fountain made of Indonesian carved stone decorated with patterns of Mickey. – Three topiaries surround the pond in the shape of Hathi Jr., the baby elephant from <i>The Jungle Book</i>.
Wing design	Based on Vanuatu arched thatch roof structures.	
Little Squirt Garden	Theme	<h1 style="font-size: 2em;">Oceania</h1> 
	Layout <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Features the laid-back Oceania inspired by <i>Finding Nemo</i>. Layout <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The garden’s lawn is sculpted to emulate the rolling waves of the South Pacific, while the pathway alongside the guests’ hotel rooms resembles a sandy beach. From this shoreline pathway, guests can look out onto the rolling lawn and spot several small “atolls” or islands. – These islands feature a coral shelf or border around their edge, complementing the sea shells and starfish imprints found in the garden’s pathway. 	
<h1 style="text-align: center;">South America</h1> 	Wing design	Inspired by the vertical wood sidings and rooflines found in the Amazon area of Brazil.
	Kevin Garden	Theme <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Inspired by South America as seen in <i>Up</i>, with bright colors and bold distinct lines. – Located outside the World of Color Restaurant, the garden begins on the terrace. Layout <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The pathways intertwine into an artistic leaf pattern. – Common herbs used in cooking such as rosemary, lavender and lemongrass can be found in an herb garden.

Wing design	Inspired by the mud wall patterns from Ghana, and mud and stick construction seen in Cameroon.	<h1 style="text-align: center;">Africa</h1> 
Rafiki Garden	<p>Theme</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – An African Savannah inspired by <i>The Lion King</i>. <p>Layout</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Emulates a windswept African Savannah, with grasses throughout the garden planted to create a spacious undulating landscape. – The garden’s pathways, filled with tire marks and animal tracks, appear muddy and cracked, worn by years of travelers going out on safari. – The garden’s centerpiece is a large fire pit that also serves as a campfire.

As part of the hotel’s incredible theme, guests can also find Disney friends here wearing all-new exploration outfits. Mickey Mouse, Minnie Mouse, Donald Duck and Goofy have banded together to form an expedition team, respectively taking on new roles as an explorer, adventuress, bird-watcher and pilot. Guests will be greeted by the Disney friends in their brand-new outfits when having buffet at Dragon Wind Restaurant. Get ready for a pleasant surprise as Disney friends may make an unscheduled appearance in the hotel lobby!



Diversified Dining Experience

The hotel's three restaurants offer epic dining adventures with over 550 dishes and drinks. Cuisine from different parts of the world is served in three restaurants integrating various cultural elements with the hotel's exploration theme. These restaurants are able to cater to a total of 500 guests in a single seating.

Dragon Wind

Decorated with whimsical dragon kites, Dragon Wind serves rural and classical provincial Chinese fare inspired by the Five Elements of traditional Chinese culture. Guests may be greeted by Disney friends during the buffet.
